Ripe summer cherries and elegant structure round out this pinot noir		
<b>Torbreck Shiraz</b>	<b>Barossa Valley, Australia 2008</b>	<b>\$48</b>
Full-flavored red with good fruit concentration and broad finish		
<b>Bianchi Malbec</b>	<b>Mendoza, Argentina 2007</b>	<b>\$48</b>
A well-crafted malbec with an assertive nose and generous body		
<b>Domaines Barons de Rothchild “Blason d’Aussieres”</b>	<b>Corbieres, France 2005</b>	<b>\$48</b>
From the Pyreneese Mountains, this is a dry red blend of mouvedre, grenache and syrah		
<b>75 Wine Company “The Sum”</b>	<b>CA 2008</b>	<b>\$48</b>
Well-crafted cabernet and syrah blend showing deep currant and blackberry ripe fruit		
<b>Big Bang Rioja</b>	<b>Spain 2006</b>	<b>\$48</b>
Aromas of red and dark berry preserve, following with a silky body and zesty finish		
<b>Zaumau Priorat</b>	<b>Priorat, Spain, 2008</b>	<b>\$48</b>
A dry, bold red from a hot region of Spain showing flavors of dried black and red fruits		
<b>Cataldi Madonna Montepulciano d’Abruzzo</b>	<b>Italy 2007</b>	<b>\$49</b>
A dry, rich wine with earthy finish.		
<b>Amancaya</b>	<b>Argentina 2008</b>	<b>\$50</b>
An appealing blend of malbec and cabernet		
<b>Chateau Ducla Bordeaux Superieur</b>	<b>France, 2005</b>	<b>\$50</b>
A dry French red blend with delicate tannins, hints of spice and cedar		
<b>Silverado Merlot</b>	<b>Napa, CA, 2005</b>	<b>\$50</b>
An ample merlot with a tempting nose of blackberry and cacao hints, broad finish		
<b>J.Gott Cabernet Sauvignon</b>	<b>Napa, CA 2007</b>	<b>\$50</b>
Grapes sourced from Oakville and Howell Mountain, this is a lush cabernet with lingering finish		
<b>Mont Gras Antu</b>	<b>Chile, 2007</b>	<b>\$52</b>
Antu is mainly cabernet with some carmenere blended in to add extra nose. Full-dark fruit flavored		
<b>Rodney Strong Cabernet Sauvignon</b>	<b>Alexander Valley, CA 2006</b>	<b>\$52</b>
A full red with lively tannins, blackberry fruit and hints of spice and oak with a full finish		
<b>Nemea Grande Reserve Cuveé</b>	<b>Greece 2005</b>	<b>\$55</b>
Made from the Aghiorghitiko grape, it shows ripe red fruits in the nose with plum and blackberry		
<b>Seghesio Sangiovese</b>	<b>Alexander Valley, CA 2007</b>	<b>\$65</b>
First planted here in 1910, this Italian varietal shows how well it does in California. Floral nose leads to a lengthy wine with dry oaky finish		
<b>Jacobs Creek “Cenentary Hill” Shiraz</b>	<b>Barosa Valley, Australia 2005</b>	<b>\$65</b>
Minimal filtration accents this dense shiraz with a striking broad finish		
<b>Siduri Pinot Noir</b>	<b>Willamette Valley, OR 2007</b>	<b>\$68</b>
With fruit sourced from the Chehalem Mountains, pinot noir fans will add Siduri to their cult-following wines		
<b>Marchese Antinori Chianti Classico</b>	<b>Tuscany, Italy 2005</b>	<b>\$70</b>
Charming floral nose followed by rustic dry red fruits. A true Tuscan treasure		
<b>Estancia Meritage</b>	<b>Alexander Valley, CA 2006</b>	<b>\$75</b>
An American style Bordeaux blend of Merlot and Cabernet. This is a full wine with deep crimson color and velvety texture. Soft oak finish.		
<b>Chappallet Mountain Cuvé</b>	<b>Napa, CA 2007</b>	<b>\$75</b>
An alarmingly good meritage blend. Floral, broad nose with flavors of blackberry and casis		
<b>Kathryn Hall Cabernet Sauvignon</b>	<b>Napa, CA 2005</b>	<b>\$85</b>
An assertive cabernet with long racy finish		
<b>Brewer Clifton Pinot Noir</b>	<b>Sta. Rita Hills, CA, 2008</b>	<b>\$85</b>
Lush and lively with hints of baked cherry pie and truffle		
<b>Ceretto Barolo</b>	<b>Piedmonte, Italy, 2004</b>	<b>\$88</b>
Dry aggressive red with dense smooth tannins		
<b>Chateau Corneil-Figeac Gran Cru</b>	<b>St. Emilion, France 2005</b>	<b>\$90</b>
A full brodeaux with hints of currants, silky tannins and long finish		
<b>Sartori “Corte Bra” Amarone</b>	<b>Veneto, Italy, 2003</b>	<b>\$105</b>
Nose shows ripe berry & plum. Full-bodied, rich yet velvety smooth. Slight oak finish.		
<b>Duckhorn Paraduxx</b>	<b>Napa, CA 2006</b>	<b>\$120</b>
A wine that exudes flavor. Deep penetrating fruit with excellence achieved!
