Aromas of red and dark berry preserve, following with a silky body and zesty finish

A dry, bold red from a hot region of Spain showing flavors of dried black and red fruits		
Cataldi Madonna Montepulciano d’Abruzzo	Italy 2007	\$49
A dry, rich wine with earthy finish.

A dry French red blend with delicate tannins, hints of spice and cedar

An ample merlot with a tempting nose of blackberry and cocoa hints, broad finish		
Mont Gras Antu	Chile, 2007	\$52
Antu is mainly cabernet with some carmenere blended in to add extra nose. Full-dark fruit flavored

A full red with lively tannins, blackberry fruit and hints of spice and oak with a full finish		
Nemea Grande Reserve Cuveé	Greece 2005	\$55
Made from the Aghiorghitiko grape, it shows ripe red fruits in the nose with plum and blackberry		
Corte Giara Ripasso	Verona, Italy 2007	\$56
Called baby amarone, this ripasso has a generous bouquet and flavors of jammy ripe fruit		
Stratton Lumis Cabernet Sauvignon	Napa, CA 2006	\$60
Heady ripe red with blackberry and oak		
Miner Sangiovese	Gibson Ranch Mendocino, CA 2007	\$65
A full-flavored style sangiovese brimming with plum and red berry fruit		
Jacobs Creek “Cenentary Hill” Shiraz	Barosa Valley, Australia 2005	\$65
Minimal filtration accents this dense shiraz with a striking broad finish		
Siduri Pinot Noir	Willamette Valley, OR 2007	\$68

Seghesio Old Vine Zinfandel	Sonoma, CA 2007	\$85
Big, bold zin with hints of pepper and spice

Lush and lively with hints of baked cherry pie and truffle		
Paul Hobbs Cabernet Sauvignon	Napa, CA 2007	\$85
Elegant and balanced, generous ripe dark fruits finish with toasty oak

A full brodeaux with hints of currants, silky tannins and long finish
